

Perinatal fellowship for social workers and mental health counselors at Strong Roots Counseling. Sept 15, 2024 -September 14, 2025

Strong Roots Counseling is pleased to announce the second year of our perinatal fellowship at Strong Roots Counseling open to **social work and mental health clinicians who have a Master's degree from an accredited school of social work or graduate school of mental health counseling and possess a Massachusetts licensed LCSW, LICSW or LMHC or are eligible to sit for example Fall 2024.** This training will focus on developing and honing specific treatment skills in the field of perinatal mental health, as well as other related considerations for birthing persons with an emphasis on evidence-based therapy approaches. Trainees will have the opportunity to learn more about the treatment of perinatal depression, anxiety, birth trauma, loss, and IVF.

Strong Roots Counseling is a group practice located in West Newton, MA. We offer in-person, hybrid, and telehealth treatment for Massachusetts clients. Fellowship participants are recommended, but not required, to consider at least one day in the office to see clients in person and to connect with other in person staff. Strong Roots Counseling will complete your insurance paneling process. All Strong Roots Counseling fellows are required to complete a CORI prior to employment. This is a salaried position and with all the related full-time benefits of a W-2 employee of 401K, sick, dental, LTD, and health. \$55,000 base salary for the 12-month contract with opportunities for increases as productivity allows. A computer, office, and parking will be made available to both fellows.

Applications will be accepted until August 1, 2024. Accepted applicants will be notified on August 19, 2024.

Strong Roots Counseling is committed to enhancing the workforce of perinatal providers targeting specific underserved populations, including, but not limited to: BIPOC, multilingual, underserved communities as identified by the state, and LGBTQIA+ birthing persons. When applying, please highlight how your training will impact one or more of these populations. Strong Roots Counseling is committed to creating safe space for all clients, with a particular focus on BIPOC and LGBTQIA+ people. This value is a part of our readings, training, and discussions as a staff and we are seeking people enthusiastic about making this a part of their work. All applicants will need to have completed two clinical placements for consideration.

Features of fellowship:

- Case load with emphasis on perinatal population
- Peer supervision weekly
- Weekly dyad supervision- two fellows and on site provider
- Seasoned clinician to review all intakes, treatment plans, and notes
- Reading syllabus with monthly themes
- Books and additional trainings made available through Strong Roots Counseling
- Required participation in Strong Roots Counseling certificate program October 2023 for the use of CBT for perinatal emotional complications with 12 CEUs provided
- Certificate of completion of training at the end
